Employee Right to Know

The Employee Right to Know Act is intended to insure that every employee is aware of the dangers associated with hazardous substances, harmful physical agents, or infectious agents that he or she may be exposed to in the workplace.

It is the policy of Prairie Creek Community School to provide information and training to employees who may be routinely exposed to a hazardous substance, harmful physical agent or infectious agent.

A manual of material Safety Data Sheets is available in the director's office as well as in specific areas such as maintenance.

Janet B. Johnson – PARENT'S RIGHT TO KNOW

Prairie Creek Community School recognizes the importance of our students' and employees' health and well-being. Therefore, we are examining and reducing our use of pesticides and utilizing Integrated Pest Management techniques in our building and on school grounds to minimize the possible long-term unknown health effects of pesticides.

Prairie Creek Community School will make available, in the school office, for parents and employees, the estimated schedule of application of pesticides classified by the United States Environmental Protection Agency as designated under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act. Parents may also request that the school notify him or her prior to the application of such pesticides on a day different from the days specified in the notice.
