Individual Student Quarantine - Learning from Home

- A device, charger and supplies will be sent home with the student, or arranged for pickup.
- Teachers will be given 1 full school day at the outset of the quarantine period to prepare for students to learn at home and communicate the process with parents/students. The Learning Management Systems will be SeeSaw or Google Classroom. The meeting platform, if used, will be Zoom.
- Students will be marked present if they participate in their Learn from Home plan. Parents should contact school if an excused absence is needed.
- Teachers will communicate an individual plan, including a plan for posting assignments to SeeSaw or Google Classroom. Students will be included synchronously in class activities as possible.

Individual Teacher Quarantine

If an individual teacher is required to quarantine, but their class is not, the regular substitute teacher process will be followed.

Class Quarantine

- A device, charger and supplies will be sent home with students or arranged for pickup.
- Teachers will be given 1 full school day at the outset of the quarantine period to prepare for students to learn online and communicate the process with parents/students. The Learning Management Systems will be SeeSaw or Google Classroom. The meeting platform will be Zoom.
- Students should have at least one synchronous full class session, synchronous small group or individual instruction/office hours asynchronous and offline activities each day.

Building-wide quarantine

- A device, charger and supplies will be sent home with students or arranged for pickup.
- Teachers will be given 1 full school day at the outset of the quarantine period to prepare
 for students to learn online and communicate the process with parents/students. The
 Learning Management Systems will be SeeSaw or Google Classroom. The meeting
 platform will be Zoom.
- Attendance will be taken daily.
- Students should have at least one synchronous full class session, synchronous small group or individual instruction/office hours asynchronous and offline activities each day.
