7 Items for discussion and/or reports

a Director Report The ICT continues to meet and discuss COVID protocols. They have discussed the 5th grade trip to Wolf Ridge. Children will need to be vaccinated or have a negative test prior to the trip. The decision was also made to not have any other field trips at this time. We will revisit this decision again later. Jan Malcolm sent a letter to all board members regarding COVID and protocols. This letter contained layered strategies that include: promoting vaccination, universal masking, physical distancing, staying home when sick, screening testing, contact tracing and quarantine, ventilation, notification of cases and additional layers of prevention. It was proposed that the ICT should discuss screening testing for unvaccinated students. The Northfield News published a nice article on the bridge that Sam Swedin built. Michelle M visited Prof Appleman's class. Several teachers visited Gateway School in Hopkins on the work day in November.

b Education Program Committee We have had Carleton students to visit our classrooms this fall and that has been really nice for our children. Molly and Simon attended equity leadership training, Coaching for Equity. Connie led a CPR training last Saturday for several staff. The teachers just finished their first round of lesson study. They really enjoyed it and it felt like the first time we have come together as a whole faculty to discuss the math curriculum.

c Finance Committee: The packet includes the most up-to-date information as of October 31st. Several lines have been adjusted including: subbing and technology. The budget was also adjusted to account for 178 students enrolled, shifted from 180. The finance committee also proposed a 2% stipend for December payroll. This would be a one time expenditure.

d Development Committee: GiveMN is today! We are currently at \$33,000.
