b Board / Faculty Retreat & Strategic Planning: Input from 3 different groups, the District Advisory Committee, possibly a public event for parent input and then board/faculty retreat on Monday, February 21st.

c Education Program Committee: Professional Development has had a focus on preparing for narratives in advance of conferences. Teachers have been updating the theme database, and will return to the Wednesday PD starting next week. They are going to talk about a book to read for the entire school around equity this Wednesday. Michelle B participated in a 3 day Safety Care Training to be a trainer. Going forward she will be able to train our staff and not have to outsource the training. As part of Simon's professional development he joined The Bright Morning Organization. It is a series of courses and webinars on coaching and supervising people.

d Finance Committee: The most recent financials as of 12/31/21 were reviewed. We are currently budgeting a loss of \$140k this year. No significant change since last month. The finance committee met today and we are looking forward to next year's budget. We have had a consistent budget for the last 10 years. In the last year, we have had a distribution of COVID funds which has caused more expenses and also brought in additional revenue. Next month we will look at a 5 year budget.
