

## PCCS Covid Exposure Notification

Dear PCCS families,

We were notified of a positive case of COVID-19 in a member of the PCCS community. Your child was exposed during their day at PCCS. We cannot, for privacy reasons, share details about the person. At this time, they have been told to stay home and away from other people until they are well and can no longer spread the disease.

You should monitor your child for symptoms of illness, **but they are not required to stay home unless symptoms develop**. You should continue to watch yourself or your child for COVID-19 symptoms, which include:

- Fever of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher
- New cough or a cough that gets worse
- Difficulty/hard time breathing
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- New nasal congestion/stuffy or runny nose
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- Muscle pain
- Extreme fatigue/feeling very tired
- New severe/very bad headache
- Chills

If you or your child gets symptoms, stay home and consider getting tested for COVID-19.
