b Education Program Committee

c Finance Committee

There is a current revised budget that will be presented for approval. There is also a three year budget proposal. There is a 4% increase in state aid. The budget includes changes to the cost of living and fundraising in the budget. There are new revenues entered in student support aid and school library aid. The budgeting for food service has many unknowns therefore the budget reflects an estimate based on the elements that are known. The proposed budget meets our fund balance policy. The finance committee is making a recommendation to adjust the salary schedule to a single scale from the two schedules we currently have in the school. There will be forward planning for the strategic outlook for the budget for the next 3-5 years.

d Development Committee

Currently the school has raised \$4875.52 from the Squirrel Jam fundraiser. There are opportunities to expand the event in the future.
